## Contraindications to Kidney Transplant Referral\*

- □ eGFR >25 mL/min
- □ Age 70 or older unless:
  - patient has a living donor
  - patient was a previous living kidney donor themself
  - patient has received a liver transplant in the past year
  - patient has at least 5 years on dialysis
- □ Active tobacco use within 3 months (includes all methods: inhaled/chewed/vaping)
- Inability to walk one block (i.e., 300 feet), except for patients with a spinal cord disorder or lower extremity amputation
- □ BMI ≥40
- □ Stage 4 metastatic cancer actively treated within the last 5 years
- □ Severe progressive dementia
- Active angina
- □ Abuse of alcohol within 3 months
- □ Abuse of illegal substances (except oral cannabinoids) within 3 months
- □ Unstable living environment (transient/homeless, etc.)
- □ Active noncompliance/nonadherence to medical treatment
- □ Severe untreated psychiatric disease
